GENERAL NOTICE OF RACE

November,25th 2021

# 1. GENERAL

The Atlantic Watersports Committee and the City of Viana Do Castelo warmly invite the regions and countries of the European Atlantic Area to participate in the 23rd Atlantic Games 2022. The Atlantic Watersports Committee reserves the right to host other regions and countries.

The Atlantic Games 2022 will take place in the Viana Do Castelo from July 11th to 15th, 2022

the following sports will be represented during the Atlantic Games 2022,:Rowing (Olympic and Coastal), Kayak ( Canoe Sprint , Kayak Polo, Va'a ), Finswimming , Open Water Swimming , Surfing , Surf Life Saving, Sailing under the supervision of Federations following federation and institutions:

- Federação Portuguesa de Canoagem (FPC)
- Federação Portuguesa de Remo (FPR)
- Federação Portuguesa de Surf (FPS)
- Federação Portuguesa de Vela (FPV)
- Federação Portuguesa de Natação (FPN)
- Federação Portuguesa de Actividades Subaquáticas (FPAS)
- Federação Portuguesa de Nadadores-Salvadores (FPNS)

The sites of competitions will be:

- Lima River Olympic Rowing, Canoeing, Finswimming and Open Water Swimming
- Cabedelo Beach Surf
- Cabedelo Beach Sailing, Surf life saving.

## 2. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Atlantic Games 2022 are organized by the City Of Viana do Castelo, in collaboration with the following entities:

#### 3. RULES

- a. The competition will be governed by the Racing Rules of the following International Federations:
  - International Sailing Federation (ISAF)
  - International Canoe Federation (ICF)
  - International Rowing Federation (FISA)
  - World Underwater Federation (CMAS)
  - European Surfing Federation (ESF)
  - International Swimming Federation (FINA)
  - International Life Saving Federation (ILS)
  - Atlantic Watersports Committee Sports Regulations
  - The 2022 Atlantic Games General Notice of Race

## b. Advertising

Competitors may be required to display sponsor advertising supplied by the organizing authority.

#### c. Image rights: filming, reports, indication of names, broadcasting...

Competitors may be:

- • Photographed,
- • Filmed for the productions of videos and a DVD,
- Interviewed for the press,
- • Have their names and images published in the press, the web sites of the Games.

All documents can be used by the International Committee in perpetuity in all forms of media including internet for information and promotion.

## 5. SUPPLIED EQUIPMENT

A sport (including disqualification of the competitor) or financial penalty may be given and the use of a boat may be withdrawn if, in the opinion of the organizing authority, a competitor treats or handles a boat or a board without care or in a manner which causes or is likely to cause damage to the boat or the board.

The organizing authority will not supply technical devices, or accessories, or any other personal equipment.

No modifications to a boat, a board or any other equipment shall be made without unless authorized by the organizing authority.





## 6. ELIGIBILITY

## a. Participating teams

The participation of athletes is done within the framework of teams representing either a Country, a Region or a City of the Atlantic Arc. The Atlantic Arc comprises the following countries: Ireland, United Kingdom, France, Spain, Portugal.

These teams are set up by the national, regional or local sports authorities of these countries, regions or cities.

The participation of teams representing other cities, regions or countries is possible. In this case, an official request must be sent to the Atlantic Committee.

## b. Club Membership and Licenses

Each competitor must be a member of a Club located in the territory or city that their team represents.

Each competitor must be a member of a Sports Federation consistent with his competitive practice and with the territory or city that his team represents.

Each competitor must have an individual sporting license issued by his Federation. In the case of a Federation which does not issue a license, it must have a "civil liability" insurance as provided by its Federation.

The Atlantic Committee will resolve any request or dispute regarding the determination of the national or regional authority that a competitor represents.

## c. Flags of the participating teams

Each team is required to bring to the venues their national or regional flag, in approximate size 2.5 x 1m, and a CD/MP3 with the national or regional anthem.

## 7. REGISTRATIONS

## a. Pre-registrations

The countries and regions must provide before  $1_{th}$  March 2022, a pre-registration with :

- the definitive number of the sports in which they will participate (number of sports teams presented by every country or region),
- the number of competitors of their teams.

## b. Sports Registration Schedule

Registrations must be made from 1 March 2022, on the Atlantic Committee web page <u>www.atlanticgames.eu</u> (contact@atlanticgames.eu), by participating national, regional or local sport authorities.

The registration period is divided into 2 phases:

- Phase 1: before May 15, 2022
- Phase 2: after May 15 and until July 1, 2022

Entries will be closed on July 1, 2022 at 24:00 UTC.

#### c. Late registration

The Committee reserves the right to accept late entries. (after July 1st 2022).

#### d. Registration fees

The registration fee per participating sportsman is defined according to

- The phase (1 or 2) of registration
- membership or non-member status of the Atlantic Water Sports Committee, presented by the Athlete's membership organization.

The membership of the Atlantic Water Sports Committee is acquired upon payment of the membership fee. The 2022 and 2023 bi-annual subscription is set at 70 euros

The registration fees are defined as follows:

Any unpaid or unconfirmed entries at the close of registration confirmation on July 12 at 5:00 pm will be canceled.

A competitor taking part in several sports (for example, a competitor who participates in swimming in open water and also surf life saving) will be obliged to pay as many entries as sports he wants to participate.





A competitor taking part in several events of the same sport will pay only one entry.

#### e. Confirmation of the registration

Each competitor's registration will be confirmed on July 11th from 10 am to 6h30 pm and on July 12<sup>th</sup> from 10 am to 5 pm at the General Secretary of the Atlantic Games.

The following documents will have to be presented:

- Official Sports license (countries or regions having one).
- Public Liability Insurance certificate. (Countries or regions who don't have federative licenses)
- Parental approvals (when necessary).

#### f. Tasks of the national, regional or local authorities

The Team Leaders have to:

- Select the teams
- • Gather information from competitors
- • Submit team details, the entry applications and fees to the International Committee.
- • Collect parental approvals (forms available on <u>www.atlanticgames.eu</u>) and forward them to the Atlantic Watersports Committee.
- • Coordinate and pay for transport of their teams.
- • Coordinate and pay for accommodation and catering of their teams.

#### 8. SECURITY

all established safety norms must be respected, generally speaking, and for each different sport.

#### 9. ACCOMMODATION, CATERING

## a. Plan of accommodation

The city of Viana do Castelo will propose accommodation and a catering service, from the dinner of July 11 to the dinner of July 15, 2022 for a maximum of 200 euros (4 nights, 4 lunches and 5 dinners). (see annexes).

## **10. BOAT RENTAL AND DAMAGE DEPOSITS**

#### a. Boat rental

The city of Viana do Castelo may propose for hire a certain number of boats (see appendices).

#### b. Deposit for boat rental

Participating teams must provide a deposit (checks or cash) of 500 € at the confirmation of registration to cover any damage, loss or damage they may cause on the nautical supports provided or rented.

The deposit will be the limit of liability for each incident; in the event that a deduction is made in the deposit, the concerned athlete must return the initial value to maintain his eligibility as a participant.

- 7:00 pm: Sports Team Leaders meetings by sport and presentation of the results of the day

#### d. Thursday 14th July

- 9:00 am to 7:00 pm Competitions on sites with schedules adapted to sports events
- 7:00 pm: Sports Team Leaders meetings by sport and presentation of the results of the day
- Animation during the day and evening (program to specify)

#### e. Friday, July 15th:

- 9:00 am to 3:00 pm Competitions on sites with schedules adapted to the sporting events
- 4.30 pm: presentation of results and Closing Ceremony
- 18h00: Dinner and Departure of delegations.

## 12. GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

The rankings in each sport and event will be validated by the participation of at least three teams in each sport and event.

#### a. Ranking of Events

The ranking system of individual competitors or crews in each event will be defined in the sailing instructions, in accordance with the rules of each sport.

## b. Sports Ranking

The ranking system of participating teams in each sport will be defined in the sailing instructions, in accordance with the rules of each sport. Otherwise, the ranking will be established by counting the number of gold medals obtained by each team in the sport concerned.





## c. Atlantic Games Overall Ranking

The Atlantic Games General Classification concerns all the teams participating in the Atlantic Games, whether these teams are involved in a sport or that they are involved in several sports.

This ranking will be established from the rankings of the Sports, by adding the places obtained by each team in each sport.

- If a team ranks first of one of the sports, it scores 1 point, if it ranks 2nd, it scores 2 points, if it ranks 3rd, it scores 3 points ....
- If a team does not participate in a sport, it scores a number of points equal to the total number of teams registered in the Atlantic Games

## 13. TROPHIES

The following prizes will be awarded:

- Individual trophies in the first three of each event (if there is a minimum of three participating teams in each event).
- "Sport" trophies to the first three teams of each sport (subject to the participation of a minimum of three teams in the sport concerned).
- Atlantic Games trophies to the first three teams in all sports in the Games ranking (subject to the participation of a minimum of three teams).

#### 14. PARTICULAR INSTRUCTIONS

The particular instructions will be available for all competitors at registration confirmation in the Municipality of Viana do Castelo.

#### **15. INTERNATIONAL JURY**

Where possible, in all the disciplines competing, an international jury will be appointed by the

Organization Committee with the agreement of the International Committee.

#### 16. DRUG TESTING

Drug testing may take place during the competition.

#### **17. MEASUREMENT**

Measurement checks may be carried out by the race committees at any time on any boat or board to ensure compliance with the rules.

#### 18. LIABILITY

The competitors take part in the Games under their own responsibility. Neither the organizing authority nor any person or entities involved in the organization of the event accept any liability for injury or loss of life or property caused by or in conjunction with the Games.

The competitor is free to choose to participate or not in a competition.





The Organization Committee may demand payment of any damage provoked by the wrong use of nautical installations and official accommodation. It may also evict any competitor for bad behavior, independently from the actions of the Jury.
